

Mae pentref **Tremeirchion**, a enwyd yn wreiddiol yn Dinmeirchion-sef caer y Pennaeth Meirchion-yn bentref deniadol a hynafol. Y mai hi bron yn sicr i Ffynnon Beuno yn y Graig gael ei enwi ar ôl i Sant Beuno deithio drwy y pentref yn y chweched ganrif.

Tremeirchion, originally named Dinmeirchion-fortress of Meirchion the Chieftain-is an attractive village ancient in origin. Ffynnon Bueno at Graig is almost certainly named after Saint Bueno who is said to have passed through the village in the sixth Century.

2 Rock Chapel

Wrth edrych i fyny tuag at y Garreg Fawr, gwelir tŵr Rock Chapel yn torri drwy linell y coed. Mae'r capel bychan hwn a adeiladwyd ar lechwedd coediog yn 1866, wedi ei leoli ar ffin ddeheuol tir Coleg Jeswit Sant Beuno. Fe dyluniwyd y capel gan fyfyrwr yn y coleg fel lle i offeiriad Jeswit astudio ac addoli



Looking up towards Garreg Fawr, the pale spire of Rock Chapel can be seen breaking through the tree line. Built on the wooded hillside in 1866, this small chapel is situated on the southern boundary of Saint Bueno's Jesuit College grounds. The chapel was designed by a college student as a place for Jesuit priests to study and worship.



3 Moel Maenefa

Bryn yng ngogledd Ardal o Harddwch Naturiol Eithriadol Bryniau Clwyd a Dyffryn Dyfrdwy ydi Moel Maenefa. Fe ystyrir Ardaloedd o Harddwch Naturiol Eithriadol (AHNE) yn rhai o'r tirweddau a drysorir fwyaf ym Mhrydain ac ynghyd â Pharciau Cenedlaethol, mae eu cymeriad arbennig yn cynrychioli ein darnau cefn gwlad gwychaf a mwyaf gwerthfawr. Ucheldir, fel Moel Maenefa ydi un o nodweddion arbennig AHNE Bryniau Clwyd a Dyffryn Dyfrdwy.

Moel Maenefa is a hill situated in the north of the Clwydian Range and Dee Valley Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty (AONB). Areas of Outstanding Natural Beauty are regarded as some of Britain's most treasured landscapes and along with National Parks, their special character represent our finest and most precious tracts of countryside. Uplands, such as Moel Maenefa are one of the special features of the Clwydian Range and Dee Valley AONB.



1 Marchnad Bentref Tremeirchion

Ar ddydd Sadwrn cyntaf pob mis, cynhelir marchnad bentref yn yr Hen Ysgol, Tremeirchion. O 10:30yb - 12:30yp bydd stondinau'n gwerthu amrywiaeth o gynnyrch cartref fel cacennau, bara, crwst a chrefftau, yn ogystal ag wyau a ffrwythau a llysiau tymhorol. Mae lluniaeth ysgafn ar gael hefyd.

1 Tremeirchion Village Market

On the 1st Saturday of every month a village market is held in the Old School, Tremeirchion. Running from 10:30am - 12:30pm, stalls sell a variety of homemade produce such as cakes, bread, pastries and crafts, as well as eggs and seasonal fruit and vegetables. Refreshments are also available.

1 Llywybr Clawdd Offa

Mae Llywybr Cenedlaethol Clawdd Offa yn rhedeg ar hyd Cymru, o Gas-Gwent i Brestatyn trwy dirweddau godidog ac amrywiol. Y Llywybr 177 milltir, a agorwyd ym 1971, yw un o Lwybrau Cenedlaethol mwyaf poblogaidd ac adnabyddus Prydain. Yn Nhremeirchion mae y Llywybr Cenedlaethol yn mynd dros lethrau isaf Moel Maenefa, ac ar ddiwrnod clir gelli'r gweld tŵr Blackpool o'r brig.

1 Offa's Dyke Path National Trail

Offa's Dyke Path National Trail runs the length of Wales, from Chepstow to Prestatyn through magnificent and varied landscapes. The 177 mile long path, which opened in 1971, is one of Britain's most popular and well known National Trails. In Tremeirchion, the National Trail passes over the lower slopes of Moel Maenefa, and on a clear day, Blackpool Tower can be seen from the top.
